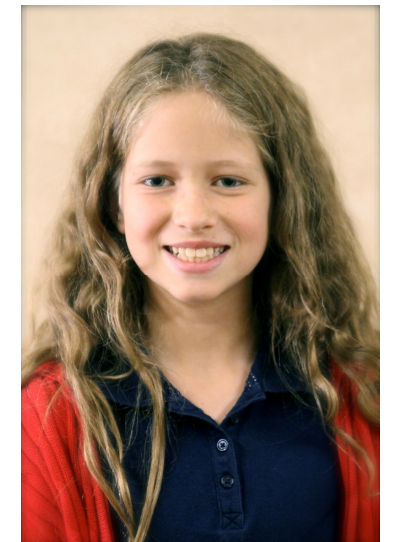

"Preparing for the Test" booklets are available in the school office for anyone that wants one.

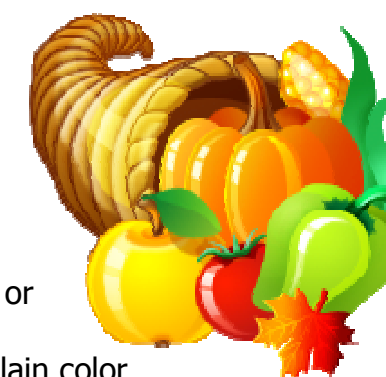
